How SAP S/4HANA drives a tank



THE BACKGROUND

Bailey is a New Zealand-owned company established in 1973 by Ian Bailey. Ian pioneered the plastic industry in New Zealand and led the way in adopting new machinery and technology.

Bailey initially focused on designing and manufacturing containers for transporting and storing Dangerous Goods. Today, they are still one of the leading manufacturers of IBCs (Intermediary Bulk Containers) in New Zealand.

The company focuses on producing the "highest quality product possible" and "to provide the best possible level of service to their customers".

In the last 40-plus years, Bailey has produced excellent quality products. However, they strive to improve the product by investing in research and development, allowing them to extend their range of water management products to include the Slimline tank range and the SUBs range of underground tanks.

THE CHALLENGE

With a focus on the future and continuing with this investment locally, Bailey is looking to expand to offshore markets and put even greater effort into developing products that care for the environment. With this goal in mind, they needed an enterprise resource planning (ERP) tool that was up to the task.

Bailey also had the challenge of needing help changing their business process. The current ERP solution was old and no longer fit for purpose due to the software version and the hardware it was running on.

They needed a new ERP system to help improve efficiency throughout their business, reduce manual paper processes in manufacturing and endto-end manual processes, including transportation management.



THE SOLUTION

With the Bailey requirements in mind, Realtech proposed a move to SAP S/4HANA Public Cloud. This SAP solution supports the business's future growth and further process improvement opportunities.
